

The following is a summary of enhancements and developments going live in this release. This document provides a summary of the release items followed by a more detailed explanation of each of the included items.

RELEASE SUMMARY

FEATURE	SUMMARY
HTML Alerts	The HTML alerts option previously available in Westlaw HK and Westlaw Malaysia will be added to Westlaw Asia.
Trail	The trail available in Westlaw HK and Westlaw Malaysia is being reinstated in Westlaw Asia.
My Folders	A new feature enabling users to save documents from their research into customised folders.
Highlighting and Annotations	Within documents on Westlaw Asia, a user will be able to highlight text and to add notes pertinent to their research. Especially useful for reminding a user why they have saved the document in their folder.
Korea tab	A new Korea Tab will be added to the Jurisdiction view enabling access to Korean case law, journals, current awareness and commentary.
Korea homepage search	A new search tick-box and dropdown option will be added to the content type and jurisdiction homepages respectively.
Recent Documents	This feature allows users to easily switch between recent documents viewed in their current research session.
Alerts Timing Change	Please note that the timing of all alerts will change to align with the alert timings of other regional Westlaw services. This will be at approximately 9/10pm going forward.

HTML Alerts

In the Manage Alert screen, Westlaw Asia has reinstated the HTML format option.

When a user sets up an alert it is now possible to select HTML format from the dropdown and setup the alert in the same way as normal.

Trail

In the Trail feature, accessible at the top right hand side of the screen, we have applied the functionality previously available in Westlaw HK and Westlaw Malaysia, whereby a user can view all the transactions types in a single list.

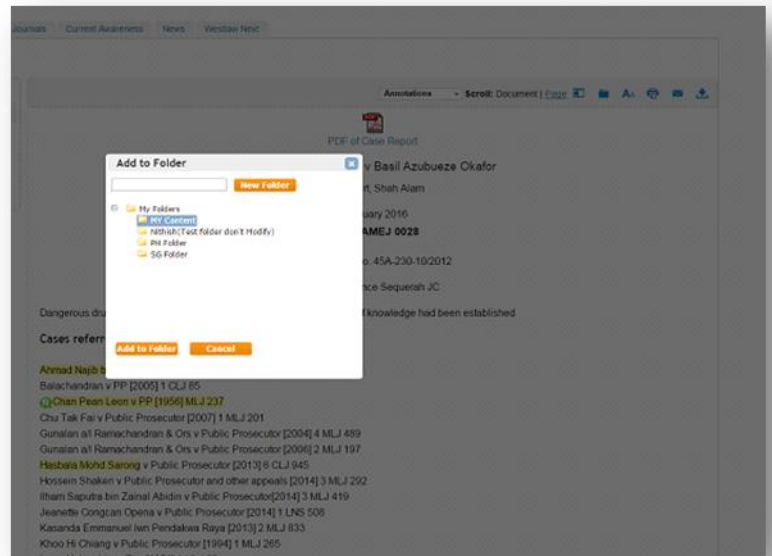

My Folders

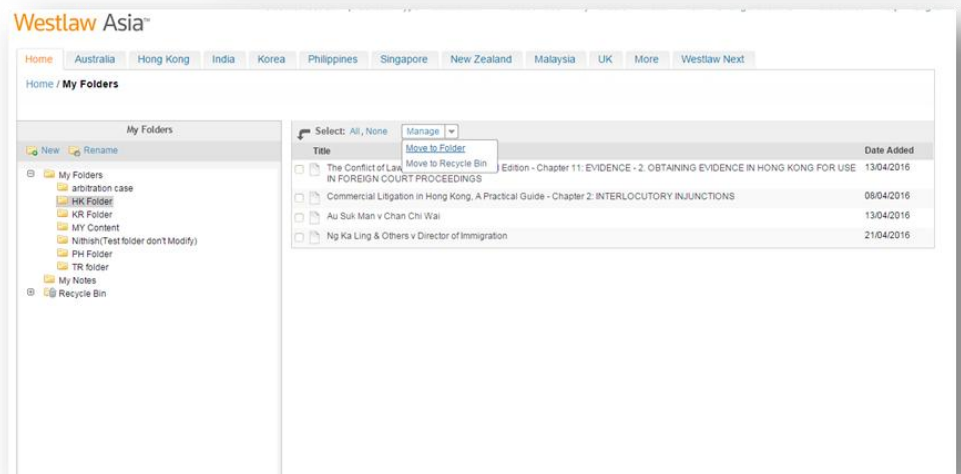
This new feature enables customers to save documents that are useful for their research into folders relating to the matters they are working on.

When in a document a user can add this to their folder by clicking on the folder icon next to print/save/email icons.

This then opens a pop-up which enables a user to select an existing folder or to create a new folder and save their selected document into the folder.



Multiple documents can be saved in the folder and then the user move documents into different folders as well as move them to the recycle bin and ultimately delete them.

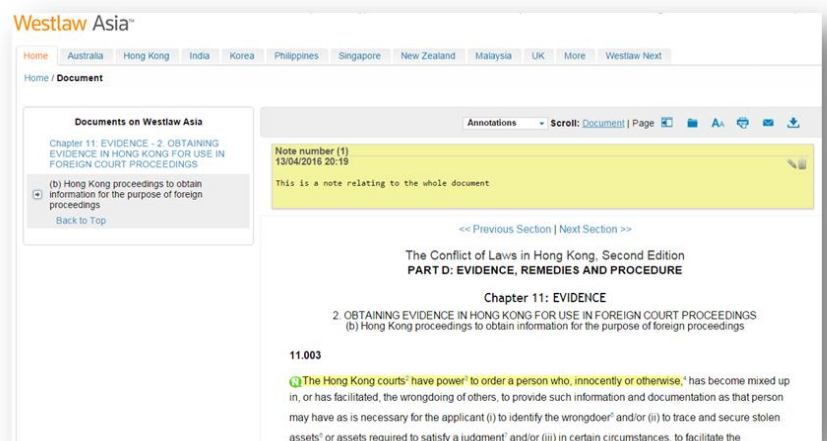


Highlighting and Annotations

Westlaw Asia now supports customers adding notes and highlights to the service.

Customers can add an overall note on the top of the document using the dropdown at the top. This appears as a yellow post-it note style box at the top of the document

Highlights are presented as yellow highlights over the text. Notes made within the text are represented by a green N icon, at the start of the highlight.
